### Footnotes

KING ROOTIN TOOTIN, reserved well off the field while guided to the inside in the opening quarter, gradually drew into contention while shifting off the inside entering the far turn, circled foes with a sharp move racing four wide into upper stretch to wrest command, shifted inwards under pressure but held sway through to the end under firm handling. NACHAS AND JOY was rated off the second flight tracking those foes three deep racing into the backstretch, shifted in while continuing under rating tracking between foes nearing the second bend, was held up in close quarters when lacking a path from which to challenge midway through the far turn, shifted to the rail nearing upper stretch while continuing with a steady advance, switched out to challenge the leader nearing midstretch but couldn't gain terms with that foe. SIR BLUEGRASS was urged to secure the lead while shifting to the rail, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into the far turn was roused to maintain the advantage nearing upper stretch but quickly gave way once headed by the winner. COPUS tracked the pace outside a rival in the second flight while racing four wide through the backstretch, continued in that path racing into the far turn while being prompted to advance, bid for command three deep between foes but lacked the needed final response. MY JOKESTER, reserved off the second flight along the rail in the opening stages, was urged to advance inside foes racing through the far turn lodging a brief bid nearing upper stretch but flattened in the drive. ITALIAN BREEZE, in touch with a rival on the pace from the outset, attended that foe's tempo under light rating for a half, was urged to press the issue between foes racing into the far turn and gave way nearing upper stretch. PIRATESINPARADISE tracked the leaders a bit off the inside as part of the second flight racing to the backstretch, shifted out three wide while being urged to prompt the pace racing into the far turn but quickly came up empty.
