Footnotes

SWEET CHI TOWN tracked the first flight unhurried a bit off the inside while within striking distance, shifted out after a half to split foes three wide in upper stretch, then wrested command from HURRICANE KATIE in the final sixteenth to prevail under firm handling. The latter went up from the break to force the pace outside a rival, dueled for command into upper stretch, gained a slight advantage near midstretch, resisted the winner to the end but came up second best. ANGEL DIVINE ducked outwards brushing SPEEDY BULLET, was settled along the inside, came through tight quarters in upper stretch and produced her best stride late to edge a rival for third. EXPLOSIVE DART was settled a bit off the inside racing into the turn, split foes in upper stretch making some progress but had no final bid. SPEEDY BULLET, brushed at the start, was settled outside rivals, made some progress on the bend, was fanned five wide in upper stretch but made no impression. WILD STORY was urged to dispute the pace racing along the rail into the turn and gave way in upper stretch. HATS N' HEELS broke outwards, was quickly righted to attend the pace three wide racing into the turn but came up empty entering upper stretch.
