Footnotes

DAZZLIN DAY was urged to secure the lead along the rail in the opening stages, dictated the pace on a narrow margin entering the bend, shifted off the inside in upper stretch but held a challenge from LITTLE MISS BE to the end under intermittent urging. The latter tracked just off the leaders outside a rival racing to the turn, angled inside the winner to challenge along the rail nearing midstretch, drew on even terms with the winner late but was outfinished. MAGIC CASE broke sharply, stalked just outside the pacesetter in the opening stages, pressed the issue on the bend into upper stretch but weakened nearing the furlong marker. TRIBUTE TO MOMMA was settled near the inside early, saved ground to upper stretch, then made an effort to improve her position inside foes late. SUE'S ALY CAT shifted off the inside tracking the leaders from well out of striking distance racing into the turn and continued evenly three and four deep to late stages. AND HOW was settled outside a rival in the opening stages and never gained striking distance. ROYAL POSH tracked just off the leaders along the rail racing into the turn and emptied out entering upper stretch. CALICO COUNTRY broke slowly and trailed throughout
