Footnotes

CAN'T STOP RAVIN was hustled to secure a clear advantage while shifting inwards a bit in the opening stages, set the pace on a clear margin racing a bit off the inside to upper stretch and held sway to the end, widening his margin under steady pressure. GILDED QUEST was settled in hand outside a rival racing well off the second flight early, gathered some momentum while shifting out four wide racing into upper stretch and continued well enough to edge a rival for place honors. COWBOY JONES, brushed at the start, tracked the pacesetter under light rating three deep in the second flight racing into the bend, continued in that path making a brief bid entering upper stretch but lacked the needed final response and lost second nearing the wire. BIG BULL, allowed to settle along the inside early, never gained contention. TWINE broke outwards brushing COWBOY JONES, was urged along between foes in pursuit of the pacesetter as part of the second flight but faded from contention early. DON'T RUSH JUSTICE, forwardly placed tracking the pacesetter along the rail racing into the bend, gave way abruptly entering upper stretch.
