CHIEF BEAR, caught a bit wide racing into the first turn while under some prompting to gain a contending position, tracked the pacesetter within striking distance unhurried to the second bend, continued with a steady advance to challenge racing into upper stretch, drifted out in late stages while responding to strong left handed prompting but prevailed in time. SICOMORO was urged to the lead along the inside racing into the first turn, dictated the pace into the far turn to upper stretch, resisted the winner's challenge but couldn't fend off that rival. GARBURETOR was settled outside foes in the opening half, split foes racing into the far turn to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch but finished evenly in late stages. NO SONG N DANCE tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight in the opening half, was caught four wide racing through the far turn while being urged to advance but emptied out in upper stretch. NICKY'S DELIGHT angled to the inside in the opening stages to track the leaders in second flight racing to the far turn but steadily retreated nearing upper stretch. TEXAS HEDGE was settled off the second flight along the inside in the opening stages but never gained contention. WISTFUL SMILE shifted out racing into the first turn carrying out the eventual winner a bit, was pulled up while shifting to the outside rail entering the backstretch, then was vanned off the course. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE RUN THROUGH THE FIRST TURN BUT NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
