Footnotes

WINDY CITY RICHIE was urged to wrest command racing outside a rival in the opening furlong, angled in once clear setting the pace racing into the bend, then drew away racing through the stretch while being kept to steady pressure. COMMANDO KAT broke outwards bumping IMMEDIATE STORM, was urged between foes in the second flight in pursuit of the pacesetter racing into the bend, couldn't gain terms with the winner but proved best of the others. IMMEDIATE STORM, bumped at the start, settled off the second flight, angled five wide racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. CUZIN DAVE, urged to position three deep in the second flight racing into the turn, was fanned four wide racing into upper stretch and steadily faded from contention. NATHAN CHICAGO, urged to a forward placing along the rail from the break, chased the leader in second flight into the bend but steadily retreated racing into upper stretch. NEWBOLD GOLD came under pressure early but lacked response. THREE RIVERS, allowed to settle in the opening stages, never gained contention.
