LADY LAVERNE vied for command from off the rail, then took the lead for good in the stretch and won going away. PRUNE'S INTEREST raced five wide near the middle of the field and rallied for the place while no match for the winner. SHE'S WILD lacked speed, angled out for the drive and gained belatedly for a share. SUMTIMSUDONT raced off the rail near the middle of the field and rallied on the turn but flattened out. LOOKATTHOSELEGS lacked speed off the rail and moved up a bit in the stretch but never reached contention. MS. KINSEY contested the pace from the inside and tired. MISSED CONNECTION raced close up off the rail but gave way in the drive. DOING IT OUR WAY was void of speed off the rail and showed little. DIRE PFYNT was always outrun. HOLY TO US raced close up inside but was through early.
