REMEMBERMEALWAYS was rated just out of striking distance outside a rival in the opening stages, steadily advanced on the leaders between foes racing into upper stretch while continuing in close quarters, shifted three deep nearing midstretch while being urged to challenge, then quickly took command and drew away under some hand urging. OUR ELEANOR joined the pace between foes soon after the break, pressed the issue outside a rival into upper stretch but proved no match when confronted by the winner while clearly best of the others. DOLLY PEACH angled inwards early to stalk just off the first flight racing along the rail into the turn, lost her path to the pacesetter while lacking the needed kick racing into upper stretch but shifted outside that foe in late stages to edge that rival for a share. FISCAL FITNESS was hustled up the rail soon after the break to dispute the lead, dueled for command a bit off the inside on the turn, shifted inwards racing into upper stretch and emptied out leaving the furlong marker. PRAIRE COUGAR was urged to secure a forward placing three deep racing just off the dueling leaders, couldn't match those foes after a half and gave way entering upper stretch. CIRCULAR STREET, allowed to settle in last off the inside racing to the bend, never gained contention.
