Footnotes

HOPE FOR TODAY was urged to secure the lead while angling to the inside racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a clear margin while under light rating racing to the far turn, forged clear when given his cue nearing upper stretch and held sway to the end under steady pressure. GREYTAP was held up just off the second flight outside a rival in the opening half, shifted out three deep racing into upper stretch and continued with interest to secure place honors. KING ROOTIN TOOTIN, moved to a forward placing racing to the first turn, stalked the pacesetter within striking distance outside a rival under some reserve to the backstretch, moved to briefly challenge the leader on the second bend but proved no match for that rival while narrowly lasting for a share. FEARLESSLY angled to the inside early tracking just off the pacesetter as part of the second flight in the opening half, lost some position to the leaders on the far turn, then shifted out four wide nearing midstretch while continuing to contest third to late stages. PEYTONVILLE was settled off the second flight between foes racing to the backstretch and continued evenly into the stretch. HE'S GOT TO RUN tracked the leaders unhurried three deep racing off the second flight into the far turn and never gained contention. PETER LOUIS tracked off the second flight along the inside in the opening stages but dropped out after a half.
