Footnotes

TELLME ALL ABOUTIT broke outwards brushing SCARLETT'S SEQUEL, was righted to force the pace outside a rival racing into the turn, shifted out while gaining a narrow advantage in upper stretch, then drifted out in the final furlong while being roused right handed to maintain her advantage. SILK OF SARI stalked just off and outside the first flight in the opening quarter, shifted out leaving the turn to bid four deep entering upper stretch but couldn't quite gain even terms with the winner. PREMIUM CUT was settled in hand along the inside in the opening quarter, switched out after a half commencing her advance, was fanned five wide in upper stretch and finished evenly in late stages. AIR STRIPE broke inwards bumping SCRALETT'S SEQUEL, was righted while being guided to the rail to track just off the leaders, came through when presented an opening to lodge a brief bid in upper stretch but flattened out in the last furlong. BEA'S HARD SIX went up from the break to dispute the pace inside the eventual winner and gave way in upper stretch. SCARLETT'S SEQUEL, bumped, pinched back, then held up out of close quarters at the start, was roused to gain contention nearing upper stretch but made no impression on the leaders. KNOTTS tracked the pace unhurried four deep in early stages but steadily faded from contention on the turn.
