Footnotes

DUBIOUS secured a position in the second flight racing along the rail to the backstretch, steadily drew into striking position on the far turn, shifted out to challenge three wide between foes near the furlong marker, then wrested command and held safe the challenge of SASSY BUCK in the closing stages under firm handling. The latter was allowed to settle in last racing to the far turn, gathered momentum while switching outside foes, swung five wide entering upper stretch and continued to make solid progress to late stages. NEVERRGUWITHRICHIE, off a bit awkwardly, was urged between foes to gain terms with a rival on the pace, attended the tempo for a half, pressed the issue racing into upper stretch to gain a brief advantage but failed to contain the winner's bid. U S S INCHON sped to the fore along the rail racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin into the far turn, resisted a rival racing into upper stretch but weakened leaving the furlong marker. SIN BIN tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch but dropped out of contention on the far turn. TARVA tracked off the second flight to the backstretch and never gained striking distance. ARMS RACE tracked the leaders three deep in the second flight in the opening half but steadily retreated nearing upper stretch.
