CROSS EYED MARY was guided to the rail in the opening stages tracking the first flight unhurried from just out of striking distance, made steady progress inside foes on the turn, shifted outside the pacesetter in upper stretch while continuing to move to terms with that foe leaving the furlong marker, then wrested command under brisk handling in the last furlong to prove best nearing the wire. DONATE was urged to the fore along the inside from the break, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin racing into the turn, extended her advantage racing into upper stretch, resisted the winner's challenge to late stages but came up second best. DIVA'S DIAMOND angled inwards to track off the first flight between foes in the opening stages, was prompted to advance nearing upper stretch while being fanned five wide racing into the lane but continued in that path in an effort to improve position. BASIC VALUES broke in the air losing position to the field, settled into stride along the inside racing to the turn, saved ground to upper stretch and gained some position late while making little impression on the leaders. PINK LENINATE was urged to gain a forward placing three deep in the opening stages, chased the pacesetter between foes in that path into upper stretch but quickly came up empty in the drive. ISLET, in touch with the pacesetter while between foes in the opening stages, chased that rival into the turn and gave way entering upper stretch. MIDNIGHT LACE was settled outside foes in the opening stages and never seriously menaced.
