Footnotes

ANEWPAIROFSHOES was urged four deep racing to the first turn joining the pace, shifted in racing to the backstretch to dictate terms a bit off the inside racing to the far turn, forged clear racing into upper stretch and was kept to steady pressure. LOOKINATMINDY, forwardly placed between foes racing into the first turn, tracked off the first flight to the second bend, made a brief bid between foes on the far turn but couldn't match terms with the winner while proving best of the others. MARK THESCORE EVEN settled into stride near the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out four wide racing into the far turn while being urged to advance, gained contention in that path entering upper stretch and finished evenly in late stages. MYA FACCIA BELLA tracked off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, shifted out three deep racing into upper stretch and continued evenly to late stages. WILDWOOD DOMAIN tracked off the second flight while angling to the inside, saved ground on the far turn to upper stretch but had no late response. SCORPIOBDANCING settled off the second flight in the opening stages and never gained contention. IZZAEVEN, caught four wide racing to the backstretch, never mounted a serious bid. EILEEN EVELYN tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight, made a brief, three wide bid racing through the far turn but quickly flattened out. MYSTERY RIDGE was a brief factor three deep between foes chasing the pace into the backstretch but steadily retreated after a half. DUBIOUS broke inwards making some contact with the eventual winner at the start, was reserved along the inside racing to the far turn and never mounted a serious challenge. SUSPENDED MOON was urged to a forward placing along the inside while briefly disputing the lead, couldn't match the winner nearing the far turn and steadily retreated racing into the stretch.
