DIXIE'S BACK broke sharply to dispute the pace on a narrow margin between foes in the opening stages while angling nearer to the inside, edged forward to a clear advantage between calls entering the turn while dictating the pace a bit off the rail, was roused to turn back a challenger entering upper stretch to regain a clear advantage and just held RETAIL REGER safe to the end under firm handling. The latter, urged to the terms with the pacesetter while shifting to the inside in the opening stages, ceded the lead to the eventual winner entering the bend to stalk just off that rival along the rail, steadied twice leaving the five sixteenths marker approaching upper stretch, switched out nearing midstretch and produced a steady late response to gain terms with the winner approaching the wire while proving only second best. DREYMORE tracked off the first flight outside rivals unhurried in the opening stages, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch and made some mild progress late. RARE ACTION settled in last along the inside in the opening stages, saved ground to upper stretch and continued evenly while improving position inside foes to the end. KATHLEEN L, in close attendance to the pace three deep in the opening stages, pressed the pacesetter in that path to upper stretch and gave way. WILD ORATION tracked off the first flight near the inside in the opening stages, shifted out four wide approaching upper stretch but had no rally. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE RIDER OF RETAIL REGER LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE WINNER ALLEGING INTERFERENCE ON THE TURN, WHICH WAS DISALLOWED.
