Footnotes

ANN ACCOLADE was hustled to the lead along the inside from the break to set the pace on a narrow margin in the opening quarter, dueled for command through the turn to upper stretch and turned back a rival to edge clear late under firm right handed encouragement. TORBO'S BANK angled to the inside stalking the pacesetter in second flight racing into the bend, shifted out three deep in upper stretch and prevailed for place honors while failing to gain terms with the winner. ON THE MAP, slow into stride, angled to the inside on the turn and made some belated progress on the rail in the final furlong. FIFTH OF APRIL ducked out at the start, was guided to the inside early tracking off the second flight, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch but had no late response. SHARP A, urged to secure a forward placing in the opening stages racing just off the leader, pressed the pacesetter on the turn to strike the front nearing upper stretch but emptied out leaving the furlong marker. CHAMPAGNE SHORES tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight in the opening quarter but retreated from contention early. JEWELINA ANNE settled near the inside early, shifted out entering the bend to race four wide through the turn and never gained contention.
