**Footnotes**

MAGIC BULLET sped to the fore outside foes in the opening sixteenth while shifting nearer to the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing a bit off the rail into the backstretch, angled to the rail nearing the second bend while continuing to dictate terms, was roused clear entering upper stretch and held sway to the end under pressure. SLAMMY BOY settled into stride near the inside in the opening half, shifted out on the far turn to race between foes, angled six wide entering upper stretch to gain a clear path and continued with interest to prevail for place honors. SWITCHING TO GLIDE was rated just off the first flight along the rail in the opening stages, was reserved while dropping back from that position nearing the backstretch, shifted out to race four wide on the far turn while being prompted to advance, continued five deep between foes into upper stretch but improved his placing to the end while being just outfinished for second. MILWAUKEE WOLF angled to the rail stalking just off the pacesetter racing into the first turn, continued in that position for a half, was held up a bit in tight quarters nearing the far turn, shifted outside the pacesetter on the far turn while being urged to challenge that foe but quickly came up empty in upper stretch. DELAGO settled outside foes in the last flight early, angled to the inside after a half, saved ground to upper stretch gaining some position nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. MILES AND MILES tracked the pace between foes in the second flight racing to the far turn, shifted out three deep on the second bend but lacked a closing response. HYDRO POWER, urged four wide racing into the first turn to gain a forward placing, continued just off the pacesetter with a three wide bid racing into the far turn and emptied out nearing upper stretch. HUNGRY WILDCAT tracked the leaders three deep in the second flight racing into to the backstretch and emptied out early.
