Footnotes

NORTHSCAPE broke sharply, was urged to maintain the advantage while shifting to the inside, dictated the pace racing into the bend, turned back a challenger to maintain the advantage in upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm right handed encouragement. DOMAIN'S RAP was urged to gain a position tracking the pacesetter inside foes in the second flight in the opening stages, steadily drew into striking distance racing into upper stretch while shifting outside the pacesetter but was always only second best. BATITO raced four deep in the second flight in the opening stages, continued with a steady bid outside foes to prompt the winner racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. STATIC KILL tracked the pacesetter between foes in the second flight, was shuffled a bit racing into the turn when bumped by BANK ACCOUNT, continued just off the second flight to race three deep between foes into upper stretch but faded in late stages. ROSSCAT broke slowly, worked his way to the inside on the turn, shifted out in upper stretch and made some belated progress to improve his placing between foes. KLIPIT settled outside foes out of striking distance early, angled six wide racing into upper stretch and gained some position while making no real impression. PENNY PINCHIN PAT tracked off the second flight near the inside early, was steadied losing position to the leaders approaching the turn and never menaced thereafter. BANK ACCOUNT angled in early while being urged to gain a position between foes three deep in the second flight, shifted in making some contact with STATIC KILL nearing the turn, continued between foes just off the inside through the turn and steadily faded in upper stretch. LOVERBIL tracked off the second flight while shifting out early, made some brief progress racing five wide through the turn but flattened out in upper stretch. HOLY BULLHIVE settled near the inside early, shifted out racing into the lane but never seriously

menaced. RIVERSHIRE settled in last while angling to the inside early and never gained contention.
