Footnotes

ECONOMIC BAILOUT, reserved in early stages racing outside a rival as part of the second flight, was held up for five furlongs, advanced readily outside foes when called upon to advance four deep leaving the second bend, came inwards a bit making some contact with CHARTER CLASS when challenging for command but continued with interest under brisk handling to prevail. JUMP TO START broke out bumping ESLA MAMBO, was quickly righted to join the pace along the inside, dispatched a rival leaving the far turn while shifting off the inside, then grudgingly resisted the winner to the end but came up second best. JAYBIRD'S MIRACLE stalked just off the leaders along the inside racing to the backstretch, came through when presented an opening in upper stretch to challenge, but failed to sustain that effort through the final furlong. ESLA MAMBO, pinched back at the start, was collected to track the leaders along the rail, saved ground to upper stretch while lodging a brief bid inside foes but came up empty in the final stages. DIXIE BANNER was settled just off the inside early, advanced leaving the far turn to challenge three wide between foes, raced in close quarters nearing the furlong marker and had no final response. CHARTER CLASS angled inwards to prompt the pace outside a rival racing to the backstretch, couldn't match that foe after six furlongs, was bumped by ECONOMIC BAILOUT in upper stretch and steadily faded from contention. DAYLIGHT CREEK, fractious in the gate before the start, broke a bit awkwardly, raced wide throughout and never gained contention.
