Footnotes

CHIEF WANDO was urged to secure the lead along the inside in the opening stages, edged away to a clear advantage on the turn to upper stretch, then gamely held the challenge of GATO'S PIRATE in the final stages to prevail under firm handling. The latter tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance along the inside in the opening quarter, shifted out four wide to bid between foes nearing upper stretch, drew on terms with the winner late but was just outfinished. BEWARE THE TIGER broke a bit awkwardly, was collected to track the leaders along the inside, saved ground to upper stretch gaining position and continued willingly to the end to close the gap and prevail for a share. BETTER MAKE MONEY settled outside foes racing to the turn, continued six deep on the bend while being urged to advance, was fanned seven wide racing into upper stretch but continued to improve position. ASHEN LORD, within striking distance four deep in the opening stages, was urged along to maintain contention while being fanned five wide racing into upper stretch and had no final response. PORT HUDSON tracked off the first flight under some reserve early, shifted inwards nearing the bend to bid between foes in close quarters nearing upper stretch but flattened out nearing midstretch. MAGIC MAN went up to prompt the pace between foes from the break, couldn't match the winner on the turn and weakened nearing midstretch. SPREAD THE CHIPS was urged to a forward placing three deep between foes early, chased the winner in that path into the bend and emptied out in late stages.
