Footnotes

L'S LEGACY was prompted from the break to secure a forward placing racing just off the first flight into the backstretch, shifted nearer to the inside racing through the backstretch while under some reserve, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, split foes near the inside to challenge for command, gained the advantage leaving the midstretch and held SMART MASTERPIECE under firm handling. The latter tracked the leaders from out of striking distance along the rail in the opening half, shifted out five wide racing into upper stretch but continued with a steady bid to close the gap while proving only second best. THREE RIVERS was urged to the fore between foes racing into the first turn, pressed the pace outside a rival racing into the far turn, resisted several challenges while between foes racing into upper stretch but couldn't fend off the top pair while lasting for a share. CREATIVE WIZARD, caught five wide racing into the first turn while under pressure to gain a forward placing, continued outside foes in the second flight tracking the leaders through the backstretch, moved to challenge three deep between foes on the far turn but was outkicked in the last furlong. POWER WOW angled to the rail racing to the first turn while being urged to dispute the pace, dueled for command inside a rival racing into the far turn and emptied out near midstretch. SEMI PRO, a bit unsettled in the gate before the start, broke slowly, was held up off the leaders while pulling a bit racing into the first turn, shifted four wide racing into the second bend making a brief advance but flattened out in upper stretch. BARANIT broke outwards bumping a rival, was settled between foes well off the second flight and never gained contention. RAP ON FELIX settled into stride along the inside, never mounted a serious bid and was gathered up in late stages. BUCKET BOY was never a factor. ADDAWAY RAJ, broke awkwardly then was bumped by BARANIT at the start and never menaced thereafter. JET E LEE BOYYY was urged to contend four deep between foes racing into the first turn, gave way abruptly after a half, was pulled up on the far turn then

was vanned off the course.
