PART'N PARCEL, forwardly placed four, then three deep in the second flight racing into the backstretch, continued with a steady, three wide advance to challenge for command nearing upper stretch, took over midstretch and held CARTOUCHE safe to the end under firm encouragement. The latter moved to gain a position just off the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, was urged to press the issue between foes racing through the far turn, shifted outside the winner leaving midstretch after being headed by that foe but continued with a solid second effort to narrow the gap. INSTILL, reserved along the inside racing to the far turn, shifted out four deep in upper stretch and displayed some belated interest. LITTLE FEAT, reserved between foes in the opening half, gained some position between foes racing through the far turn but lacked the needed final kick. B L'S TSUMANI was prompted to secure the lead along the inside in the opening stages, duelled for command inside foes racing into the far turn and gave way entering upper stretch. GO DOUG GO angled inwards to track the leaders inside foes in the second flight racing to the far turn but came up empty entering upper stretch. HURTA tracked off the second flight outside rivals in the opening half, made brief progress four wide racing into the far turn but quickly emptied out nearing upper stretch.
