### Footnotes

MERCEDES CLASS tracked off the second flight while shifting to the inside in the opening quarter, switched out nearing upper stretch to split foes four wide entering the lane and produced a solid late response to wrest command and draw clear under steady pressure. CODE OF KINGS tracked off the second flight outside foes racing into the bend, made a steady advance while shifting out five wide racing into upper stretch and continued with a steady effort to narrowly prevail for place honors. DIXIE BANNER tracked the pacesetter between foes in the second flight, shifted out on the bend to bid three deep between foes racing into upper stretch but was outkicked in the final sixteenth. U STEP ASIDE was urged to the lead along the inside, set the pace on the rail into upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum. ENEMY FIRE was urged between foes chasing the pacesetter into the bend and emptied out in upper stretch. THINKING OF SAL tracked off the second flight while racing four, then five wide into upper stretch while continuing evenly. MILWAUKEE

WOLF angled to the inside tracking off the second flight racing into the bend but steadily faded racing into upper stretch. SHERIFF MAX, allowed to settle well off the pace while wide to the turn, was caught six wide racing into the turn, was fanned eight wide entering the stretch but offered no rally. GAVILAN broke slowly losing position to the field, angled to the rail nearing the turn but never seriously menaced. SHOTGUN LUKE chased the pacesetter four wide racing into the turn and gave way after a half. BEAUCOUP GOLD was steadied between foes in close quarters after the opening furlong and quickly dropped out. NO LIP, caught five wide racing to the turn, continued seven deep between foes into the stretch and steadily retreated.
