Footnotes

GARLAND'S SPIRIT broke readily to gain a clear advantage along the rail racing to the first turn, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin while under light rating racing into the second bend, was roused clear in upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm encouragement. DEFIANT FLYER was guided to the inside early taking up a position stalking the pacesetter under rating in the opening half, was roused to advance racing into upper stretch but couldn't gain terms with the winner while proving clearly best of the others. FUN ON THE BAYOU was rated off the second flight while shifting nearer to the inside in the opening stages, shifted a bit off the inside nearing upper stretch, then angled back inside foes entering the lane while continuing with a steady effort to improve his position while failing to menace the top pair. BOSS ALLEY, urged to gain a position between foes tracking just off the pacesetter racing into the backstretch, continued in that position to upper stretch but came empty in the drive. LETHAL tracked the pacesetter three, then four wide as part of the second flight racing into the backstretch, continued in that path through the far turn and steadily faded nearing midstretch. KINGWOOD, very reluctant to load in the starting gate, broke slowly, shifted outside foes racing to the backstretch to race five deep midway through the backstretch and soon retreated from contention.
