Footnotes

INDANAMEOFDAFATHER, bumped at the start, shifted inwards racing to the first turn to track the leaders from just out of striking distance outside a rival while unhurried in the opening half, gradually drew into contention on the far turn while shifting even further off the inside, angled five wide nearing upper stretch while being prompted to advance, then continued with a steady bid in that path through the final furlong to wrest command in time under firm encouragement. TACTICS BEST, in touch with the first flight three deep between rivals in the opening stages, was eased back from that position nearing the backstretch to track just off the leaders, was urged to advance while shifting out four deep on the second bend, moved to strike the front in that path nearing midstretch but couldn't fend off the winner. GAELIC BREEZE broke outwards bumping the eventual winner, was urged to gain terms with the leaders while racing four wide into the first turn, shifted in nearing the backstretch to press the issue three deep, continued with a sustained move to force the issue in that path through the second bend, gained a narrow advantage between calls racing into upper stretch but couldn't sustain his momentum. CURZON STREET, reserved along the rail in the opening stages, saved ground throughout and made an effort to improve his position inside foes racing into the stretch. GRASS BLADE, urged to gain terms with the pacesetter racing between foes into the backstretch, exchanged some contact with that foe racing into the far turn and soon gave way. HIPPODROME trailed the field to the stretch. MANET was urged to secure the lead along the rail racing into the first turn, dueled inside foes through the backstretch, exchanged bumps approaching the second bend while continuing to skirmish with a rival into the second bend and gave way nearing upper stretch.
