Footnotes

I WANT OUT broke sharply, dictated the pace a bit off the inside in the opening quarter, angled to the rail entering the turn, held sway into upper stretch, then drew off in the closing stages while being kept to the task. JOURNEYER ducked outwards at the start, was quickly righted to secure a tracking position just inside the pacesetter in the opening stages, couldn't gain terms with that foe nearing upper stretch but continued with interest to earn the place honors. GRAY VISION tracked the leaders unhurried off the second flight near the inside early, saved ground on the bend, then shifted out in upper stretch to gain a share racing three deep between foes. J'S HONOR broke inwards, was collected to track the pacesetter three wide in second flight in the opening stages, chased the winner into upper stretch and weakened nearing the furlong marker. WINNER ALL RIGHT, a bit washy in the post parade, was righted to track between foes just off the second flight racing to the turn, angled out four wide entering upper stretch but couldn't produce a closing response. RODEO JILL broke slowly, lost position to the field and never gained contention. GRAY STAR GAL was settled outside a rival in the opening stages and never mounted a serious challenge.
