**Footnotes**

PUBLISH rated out of striking distance near the inside in the opening quarter, gathered momentum on the bend, swung out five wide entering upper stretch and produced a sustained response to reel in THE REAL CHAS in the final strides, edging that foe under firm handling. The latter, never far back, stalked just off the leaders racing to the bend, switched out three deep entering the turn advancing on those foes, took over in upper stretch, went well clear approaching the furlong marker and just failed to contain the winner. WILL'S HONEY tracked just off the leaders near the inside racing into the bend, shifted out a bit to split foes racing into upper stretch and continued with a mild bid. PROUD MCKEE, reserved along the inside in the opening stages, saved ground to upper stretch, then split foes near the inside in late stages while making some belated progress. BILL OF BILLS tracked off the second flight outside rivals, advanced to make a brief bid three wide racing through the turn but flattened out in upper stretch. CAMPO joined the pace outside a rival soon after the break, edged forward of that foe while angling to the rail on the turn but emptied out in upper stretch. SINGER'S LEGACY was settled outside foes in the opening stages and never seriously menaced. CRACK THE COGNAC broke outwards, was quickly righted, then urged to dispute the pace along the rail but was spent after three furlongs.
