PRINCESS FREEBIE was urged to secure terms with a rival on the lead, attended that foe's tempo under light rating in the opening quarter, pressed that foe nearing upper stretch, forged clear racing through the lane and steadily widened her advantage under firm encouragement. ROSSINI'S MUSE went up from the break to dictate the pace on a narrow margin along the inside under her own courage, drifted out after failing to match terms with the winner in upper stretch but continued with interest to prove best of the others. SENSATIONAL GOLD broke outwards brushing A BRUSH OF BEAUTY, was quickly righted, then urged to gain a contending position inside a rival in second flight just off the leaders after the opening quarter, switched out to challenge between foes in upper stretch, altered course leaving the three sixteenths marker to race nearest the inside and continued well enough to save a share. NIKALUK tracked behind the second flight while unhurried in the opening quarter, angled out four wide racing through the lane and continued evenly while just missing for a share. A BRUSH OF BEAUTY, brushed at the start, ducked out sharply just after the break, was urged to regain a contending position outside a rival in the second flight racing to the turn, shifted out three wide after a half while briefly challenging the top pair but flattened out in upper stretch. LUSESITA, allowed to settle in the opening quarter, swung out five wide entering upper stretch but made no impression on the leaders. MEMORY HARBOR broke outwards while being steadied a bit at the start and never menaced thereafter.
