Footnotes

SMOKY STORM gained position near the rail tracking off the second flight under some reserve racing into the backstretch, shifted outside a tiring rival to split foes after a half commencing a steady advance, wrested command after six furlongs and was driven clear under energetic handling racing through the stretch. EL TIPO, reserved near the inside just off the eventual winner racing to the backstretch, shifted out after the opening quarter making steady progress between foes, was shuffled out of close quarters after a half but continued with interest to split foes nearing upper stretch and prove best of the others. IMAGE OF SUGAR, off slowly, was reserved along the inside, shifted out five wide leaving the backstretch and steadily improved his position in that path to the end to gain a share. AIDAN'S SLEW tracked the pacesetter between foes in the second flight racing into the backstretch, advanced in tandem with the eventual winner to lodge a brief bid outside that foe racing through the far turn but emptied out in upper stretch. SEA URCHIN tracked the pacesetter three wide in the second flight in the opening stages, continued four deep into the far turn while being urged to contend but lacked the needed final bid. CATHYS BREEZE tracked off the second flight between foes in the opening half and continued evenly into the stretch. IKAROS, a bit outpaced in

the opening half, made some belated progress three deep between foes in the final quarter. MADILLAC D'VILLE, caught four wide racing into the backstretch, never gained striking distance. BARANIT tracked just off the pacesetter along the inside racing to the backstretch but was spent after a half. GOOD NEWS BLUES delayed the proceedings a bit when requiring a shoe repair in the paddock, broke inwards bumping WANNSTACHE, was sent clear racing to the backstretch, set the pace on a commanding margin for a half and emptied out once headed on the far turn. WANNSTACHE, bumped at the start, soon trailed.
