Footnotes

CHIEF WANDO, in close attendance to the pace between foes in the opening furlong, was held up just off the first flight racing into the bend, angled out four wide in upper stretch and produced a solid late response to edge STAR RATING in time under firm left handed encouragement. The latter, urged to the fore inside foes from the break, dueled for command racing nearest the rail into upper stretch, edged forward to a clear advantage nearing the furlong marker and was collared in the final stride. HIP HOPPER joined the pace between foes three deep early, dueled between foes into upper stretch but proved no match for the top two in the final furlong. LO ME, prominent four deep from the outset, pressed the pace racing three deep into the turn and gave way in upper stretch. EIGHT GAUGE settled off the inside early, came around foes racing into the stretch to improve his placing but had no final bid. TOP SERGEANT was settled along the inside, saved ground throughout but never gained striking distance. THOR'S SWORD tracked the leaders off the inside racing to the bend but dropped out of contention early.
