HAPMAN grabbed the lead at once, edged clear on the turn and maintained a healthy advantage through the stretch under firm handling. KID GUSTO reserved while four wide, was urged around the turn, moved four wide into the stretch and managed a mild bid. LOGAN'SSHOREBREEZE chased the pacesetter while racing along the inside and offered no response in the stretch. RUNNIN DA FENCES saved ground, was asked to improve on the turn and made no impact in the stretch. FROSTYBDANCING was outpaced while four wide and never a factor. GO GO MOJO reserved early, angled four wide into the stretch and had no rally. NICKY'S DELIGHT never menaced. DON NICO took no part.
