Footnotes

FIRST OF FEBRUARY attended the pace outside a rival racing to the bend, was carried out a bit by that rival nearing upper stretch, was roused to the lead and just edged LICA'S BLUFF in the final stages under firm left handed encouragement. The latter worked her way to the inside stalking just off the first flight, came through when presented an opening to challenge for command in upper stretch, led between calls late but was outfinished. SALTY RACHEL angled inwards while gaining position in the second flight, tracked the pace between foes, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, altered course to the rail in upper stretch and continued willingly to the end while never gaining terms with the top pair. MUSTANG STACEY went up to dispute the pace just off the inside from the outset, drifted out a bit after a half and weakened in the drive. CART'S LINDA chased the leaders three wide between foes racing into the bend but couldn't sustain that bid through the final quarter. MISS FONTANA swerved into the gap at the start and never gained contention. SPRINGTIME SPELL, caught four wide tracking the first flight racing to the turn, steadily retreated after a half. STRAIGHT SCOOP was outpaced early.
