Footnotes

LOCK N LOLA broke readily to gain the advantage along the inside racing into the first turn, dictated the pace along the rail on a comfortable margin to the second bend, then edged well clear of her foes through the stretch while being kept to firm encouragement. ISTEETFAA, urged to gain a forward placing three deep racing into the first turn tracking just off the pacesetter, shifted nearer to the inside on the far turn, was urged to challenge the leader racing into upper stretch but couldn't gain even terms with that foe. AFLEET ABACO, reserved along the inside in the opening stages, saved ground through the far turn, then shifted out in upper stretch while making an effort to improve her position between foes to the end. MILLENNIUM STAR bobbled at the start brushing ISTEETFAA, was righted to track just off the second flight between foes racing into the backstretch, shifted out three deep on the far turn to lodge a brief bid nearing upper stretch but quickly flattened out in late stages. APPELLA'S WONDER was urged to a contending position inside foes racing as part of the second flight in the opening half but steadily retreated racing into upper stretch. WILDWOOD BELLA tracked the leaders three deep in the second flight racing to the backstretch but emptied out early.
