Footnotes

CHANTILLY OUTLAW was urged to the lead along the inside from the break, set the pace on a clear margin racing into the turn, maintained a narrow advantage into upper stretch and responded to firm left handed encouragement to to turn back a challenge from TWO LIONS in the last furlong while shifting out a bit in late stages. The latter broke readily to gain a position just off the leader in the opening stages while being prompted to maintain striking distance, continued with a steady bid to close the gap on that foe racing into upper stretch, struck the front nearing the furlong marker and contested the issue to the end while being narrowly outfinished. C. C. BANJO broke a step slowly, was urged to gain a position inside tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance racing to the turn, shifted out on the bend while being prompted to advance, raced four deep into the stretch and edged a rival for a share in the closing stages. HOLY FEVER, urged to gain a contending position just off the leaders in the opening stages while shifting inwards a bit, switched out on the bend while being prompted to challenge three deep racing into upper stretch but couldn't produce the needed final response. BUTTERCUPS BABY, a step slow into stride, saved ground throughout to gain some position but lacked a closing response. HE'S A BAD BOY settled outside foes in the opening stages and soon dropped out of contention. BACKDOC tracked the leaders outside foes racing to the bend, angled five wide racing into upper stretch and steadily faded from contention.
