BLYDE RIVER BOY reserved while three wide, made a bold move on the turn, moved five wide into the stretch and edged clear under confident handling. FAST ALBERT settled while three wide, swung six wide into the stretch and finished well. TERRIFIC TIM chased the pace while three wide, remained three wide into the stretch and lodged a mild bid. JESS Z raced forwardly while five wide, moved four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed kick. KING AJAX was outpaced while four wide and displayed mild late interest. REGGIO'S ROCK STAR was brushed back at the start and passed tired ones. COLORADO TRAIL dueled for the lead for four furlongs and gave way late. PARTLY SUNNY never menaced. MR. HOLIDAY vied for the lead between rivals and faded. GREY KNIGHT was always outrun.
