DANDYMAN took up a position three deep in second flight tracking the pacesetter racing into the bend, was carried out by the leader racing into upper stretch while moving to challenge, altered course to challenge between foes in the four path in late stages and just prevailed in time under firm encouragement. ALERT WARRIOR tracked the pace between foes in the second flight racing into the bend, continued with a steady bid between foes racing into upper stretch to dispute the issue to late stages and was just outfinished. ROCKISLAND EXPRESS sped to the lead while shifting nearer to the inside, set the pace on a clear margin while drifting out a bit racing into upper stretch, maintained a clear advantage to midstretch but faltered late when feeling the effects of a strong crosswind. TRUEBILL, held up along the inside racing as part of the second flight, moved to challenge racing nearest the rail approaching the furlong marker and was just outkicked. DEPEND tracked off the second flight while shifting off the inside racing into the bend and lacked the needed closing bid. AUGUST DAY broke slowly and never mounted a serious challenge.
