Footnotes

ART OF SURVIVAL moved to the fore while shifting a bit off the inside dictating the pace on a narrow margin racing into the bend, turned back several challengers racing into upper stretch to gain a clear advantage in late stages and held sway on a widening margin to the end despite feeling the effects of a strong cross wind in a ridden out effort. DOUBLE FEVER prompted the pace between foes racing into the turn to upper stretch, couldn't match terms with the winner in the last furlong but held a rival for place honors. COURTESY CALL, urged along three deep in pursuit of the pacesetter racing into the turn, couldn't match that foe after a half but continued with interest to just miss second. DIRECT BREEZE, urged along five, then four wide racing into the turn racing just off the leaders, continued outside foes in the stretch while making an effort to improve position. SUE'S ALY CAT tracked just off the leaders in second flight between foes racing into the turn but lacked the needed closing bid. BABY POLLY, reserved along the inside racing as part of the second flight in the opening stages, dropped out entering upper stretch.
