Footnotes

KNIGHT AFTER NIGHT, reserved just off the leaders while gaining some cover along the inside racing through the first turn, shifted out four wide leaving the midway point of the second bend while steadily drawing on terms with the first flight, moved to challenge in that path entering upper stretch, wrested command and drew away under firm right handed encouragement. TAPILU, reserved off the field to the backstretch, swung outside foes gathering momentum racing through the far turn, shifted five wide in upper stretch and made steady late progress to edge a rival for place honors on the wire. COSTILLA RANGE urged to dispute the pace inside a rival racing into the backstretch, forced the issue inside foes into upper stretch, couldn't contain the winner and lost second on the wire. ST. MAXIMUS GATO, urged along five wide to maintain striking distance racing to the backstretch, pressed the pace three deep racing into the far turn and flattened out in upper stretch. NUCKSER was urged to dispute the pace outside a rival racing into the first turn, pressed the issue between foes into the second bend to upper stretch and gave way. MASTMAN tracked just off the leaders three deep between foes racing into the backstretch but dropped out of contention racing through the far turn. YANKEE DEALER, urged to contention four wide between foes racing through the turn, retreated from contention early.
