GOLD SPIKE raced near the middle of the field and moved up to loom a threat in the stretch but lacked a winning bid. MISS DENOUNCER was never a factor. KEEP THIS CAT raced close up three wide and tired. YOU'RE A MONKEY contested the pace from the inside and tired. BEXLEY was always outrun.
