ABSOLUT BURN raced off the rail near the middle of the field, angled out and rallied for the place while not a threat. WYLIE CHUCK lacked speed from off the rail and made a bid in the stretch but flattened out. RIVERSIDE RASCAL raced close up four wide and weakened. FRANK'S TIME raced off the rail and lacked a rally. MARLIJO'SPARTYTIME set the pace from the inside and tired. SIR SLAMDANCE was always outrun. MAGICAL TREVOR pressed the pace from off the rail and gave way.
