Footnotes

WICKLOW, reserved well out of striking distance along the inside racing to the far turn, advanced to contention along the rail racing through upper stretch, shifted out leaving the furlong marker while being roused to challenge, then wrested the advantage and kicked clear under firm encouragement. EL JAKE moved to the fore racing to the first turn, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin along the inside to the second bend, was roused to repel the winner's bid but soon proved no match while drifting out late. HOMES THE FACT, held up off the second flight between foes in the opening half, shifted out four wide racing through the far turn and continued evenly in that path to late stages while earning a share. KEY THE CODE tracked the pacesetter inside foes in the second flight racing to the far turn but offered no closing bid. PTARMIGAN MOUNTAIN tracked the leader three deep in the second flight racing to the far turn and came up empty nearing upper stretch. EL TRUENOS, urged to gain a position between foes in the second flight, tracked the leader in that position to the second bend and steadily faded racing into upper stretch.
