Footnotes

DANCING KRISTAL tracked the leaders from out of striking distance near the inside in the opening stags, made steady progress nearing upper stretch, shifted off the inside approaching the furlong marker and reeled in SASSY SHORE BREEZE in the final stages to prevail under firm encouragement. The latter, prominent along the inside from the break, attended a rival's pace while in hand racing into the bend, gained brief command in upper stretch when called upon but couldn't fend off the winner. ALASKAN ROSE, reserved in early stages, worked her way to the inside nearing the bend, then made the most of a ground saving effort to challenge inside foes belatedly to gain a share. CAROLSBEENTAUKIN tracked the pace unhurried outside foes in the opening stages, swung out five wide entering upper stretch and continued evenly. MICHALINA stalked just off and outside the first flight racing to the bend, couldn't produce the needed closing bid and steadily faded in upper stretch. ABSOLUTELY ALI, a bit slow into stride, was settled along the inside and never gained contention. RAINBOW'S SECRET broke sharply, forced the pace outside a rival racing to the turn and gave way after a half. BID ON A DANCER, caught in tight quarters at the start, was angled off the inside racing into the lane but never seriously menaced.
