**Footnotes**

RACING OFFICE JOE was urged to secure a forward placing between foes racing just off the pacesetter in the opening quarter, pressed the leader racing into upper stretch and wore down that foe in time under firm left handed encouragement. SMOKIN SILVER sped to the lead from the break while shifting a bit off the inside, held sway on a narrow margin racing into the turn to upper stretch but couldn't match terms with the winner in the final sixteenth. REPENT N RECEIVE, forwardly placed three deep between foes in the opening stages racing just off the pacesetter, moved to challenge in that path after a half but failed to sustain that effort through the final quarter. LORD AND T., urged along outside foes to maintain a contending position racing five deep in the opening stages, continued four deep on the turn into upper stretch but lacked the needed final bid. TIDY UP shifted inwards just after the start bumping KING AJAX, was collected to track off the leaders three deep racing into the turn but lacked a closing response. DOUGHNUT MAN, urged to position inside foes tracking just off the pacesetter racing into the turn, steadily faded nearing midstretch. HANGOVER CURE, held up out of tight quarters at the start, shifted to the rail early but never menaced thereafter. L. B. EXPRESS never seriously menaced. KING AJAX, bumped just after the start, was shuffled back avoiding close quarters and never menaced thereafter.
