Footnotes

B TWO SPECIAL, in touch with the first flight between foes from the outset, made steady progress to challenge the pacesetter racing into upper stretch and prevailed in the closing stages under firm handling. GEORGIE MY BOY was urged to dispute the pace inside foes from the outset, duelled for command into upper stretch, held a narrow advantage past the furlong marker and was just outfinished. BEAUCOUP GOLD settled between foes in the last flight racing to the turn, shifted out to split foes three deep entering upper stretch and made some belated progress in late stages to close the gap while earning a share. PAPER MAKER angled inwards to track off the first flight between foes racing into the bend but lacked the needed final bid. HE GONE, forwardly placed four deep tracking just off the first flight early, chased the leaders in that path racing into the turn and gave way. TALL GRASS CAT broke awkwardly losing position to the leaders and never gained contention. EPIC PHELPS was urged to dispute the pace three deep from the outset, pressed the issue in that path through the turn and gave way in upper stretch. LAKOTA WOLF tracked off the second flight racing four wide to the turn and steadily faded from contention. FAITHFUL SERVANT tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight to the bend and steadily retreated nearing upper stretch.
