Footnotes

SPIRIT PLUS secured terms with the first flight between foes in the opening stages, stalked the pacesetter racing into the bend while shifting a bit off the inside, moved to press the issue racing into upper stretch, drifted inwards a bit in late stages but prevailed in time under strong handling. FALCON POINT was urged to the lead along the inside racing to the bend, set the pace just off the inside into upper stretch, drifted a bit in late stages when feeling the effects of a strong crosswind and was just outfinished. FANNIES FUTURE, urged to striking position outside foes from the break, moved to challenge four wide racing into upper stretch and continued willingly outside the leaders to the end to prevail for a share. KIT KAT KID tracked the leaders as part of the second flight racing into the bend, bid between foes nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. WESTERN ZEN broke slowly, tracked the leaders along the inside, shifted out in upper stretch and continued evenly. GOLD ANGEL shifted to the rail early while moving to a position in the second flight, made a brief bid inside the leaders leaving the turn but quickly flattened out in upper stretch. RIO STAR hesitated at the start losing position to the field and never menaced thereafter. STAGE TAPPER was never a factor.
