Footnotes

SAMI'S IN TROUBLE sped to the lead between foes disputing the pace, dueled for command inside a rival to upper stretch, shook clear and held sway to the end under firm encouragement. WILD STORY tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight, shifted four wide racing into upper stretch and made an effort to close the gap. TELMA tracked the pace along the inside in second flight and continued willingly along the rail to late stages to prevail for a share. SILVER DIRECTION prompted the pace outside a rival racing into the bend, dueled with the winner into upper stretch and gave way. ANYONESHOME settled outside foes in early stages, swung five wide racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. JELLY BUTTER settled along the inside early but never gained contention. SURFIN WAVE reared at the start and never gained contention. THREE DAY BENDER tracked off the first flight outside a rival in the opening stages, retreated from contention early, then was vanned off the course after the race.
