THIRDWIND raced close up four wide, rallied to the lead in the stretch and drew off late. BID ON A DANCER set the pace from off the rail while pressed but could not handle the winner in the drive. SUMMER RANGE lacked speed, angled wide for the drive and gained belatedly for a share. TOKYO STORM raced off the rail near the middle of the field and improved her position. ITS LATE SEPTEMBER raced close up three wide and gave way. SASSY CHERYL lacked speed off the rail and was not a factor. BECKY'S STAR saved ground but was always outrun. LIKE A PRINCESS saved ground near the middle of the field but tired. SYRINGA SONG raced off the rail and gave way.
