Footnotes

EAST COASTER raced unhurried along the inside in the opening half tracking the pace from out of striking distance, steadily drew into contention inside a rival leaving the far turn, angled out four wide nearing upper stretch continuing well, shifted inwards a bit under pressure in the closing stages and edged SURELY JACKSON in late stages under strong handling in a well timed effort. The latter sped clear of her rivals into the first turn, dictated the pace on a clear margin a bit off the inside racing into the second bend, held sway past midstretch but couldn't contain the winner. WILD ABOUT BOYS tracked the pacesetter as part of the second flight along the rail, moved to striking distance inside the pacesetter entering the far turn, bid inside that foe nearing midstretch but was outkicked by the top pair. LINK TO MY HEART shifted off the inside tracking the pacesetter from just out of striking distance racing into the backstretch but steadily faded racing through the far turn. SHINY STAR, reserved outside foes in the second flight in the opening half, bid three deep for command leaving the far turn but quickly flattened out in upper stretch. ABSOLUTELY ALI broke slowly and trailed throughout.
