OLD EXCHANGE tracked the pacesetter outside a rival in the opening stages, commenced a steady advance to challenge nearing upper stretch, readily wrested command and drove clear. SLEW CITY BOY angled inwards to race unhurried behind the second flight in the opening stages, switched out in upper stretch and continued with interest to secure place honors late. LUCKY LEHMAN tracked the pacesetter a bit off the inside racing to the turn, came around a tiring foe in upper stretch but couldn't produce a closing bid while finishing well enough to earn a share. HARRISON COUNTY, reserved along the inside in the opening stages, switched out entering upper stretch and improved his position between foes racing through the lane. CATCH THE TRAIN sprinted clear of his foes along the rail, held sway into upper stretch but faltered once headed by the winner. INDIAN PROPHET broke slowly, switched out four wide racing into the stretch but never gained striking distance. TIZ RICH broke a bit awkwardly while swerving out, was righted to make brief progress racing three deep on the turn but emptied out in upper stretch.
