SHESA TOUGH KITTY tracked just off the leaders along the inside in second flight racing to the far turn, shifted out to split foes nearing midstretch, altered course to challenge inside the pacesetter leaving the furlong marker and wrested command in time under firm handling. RICHIEGIRLOTCLASS was settled just outside a rival in the opening half, angled out four wide entering upper stretch while moving into striking distance and edged a rival for place honors late. GAMBLER FIVE tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight, moved to challenge three deep entering upper stretch but was outfinished by the top pair. VICARY ROSE tracked off the second flight along the rail in the opening half, saved ground on the second bend, switched out in upper stretch and made some mild progress four wide in late stages. MONASHEE ROSE settled along the rail in the opening half, switched out to make a brief bid racing five wide into upper stretch but flattened out leaving the furlong marker. SUSPENDED MOON broke inwards, was urged to secure terms with a rival on the pace, attended that foe's tempo for a half, pressed the issue to gain a narrow advantage racing into upper stretch but faded nearing the furlong marker. SHEZA APPLE TU dwelt at the start and never gained striking distance. ONE WINK was urged to the lead along the inside, dueled for command into upper stretch and gave way. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE START BUT NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
