Footnotes

SPECTACULOUS, off a step behind the leaders, was hustled between foes to join the first flight in the opening furlong, dueled for command along the rail racing into the turn, edged away to a clear advantage near midstretch and held safe the challenge of RARE ACTION to the end under firm handling. The latter tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight racing to the bend, angled out four wide entering upper stretch while being urged to advance and made steady progress to the end. SECRET GLITTER, on terms with the first flight in the opening sixteenth, eased off the pace to track the leaders inside a rival in the second flight racing into the turn, shifted out to the three path racing into upper stretch while being urged to challenge but lacked the needed final kick. FIRST OF FEBRUARY broke sharply, forced the pace outside a rival racing into the turn and gave way nearing midstretch. GOLDEN TEARDROP tracked off the second flight racing to upper stretch but offered no closing bid. DOUBLENODOUBLE trailed throughout.
